← **SIMON** loves to think up new games for the gang to play. He loves sports, especially football, but he definitely needs a lot more practice!



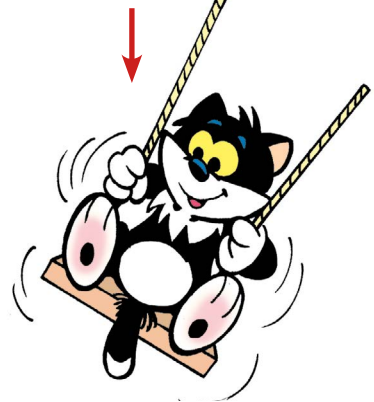
→ **BEE** is very adventurous. She loves exploring new places and making new friends, so she's really looking forward to the gang's trip to Russia.

is the mischievous mouse who's always getting into trouble. He's sweet, silly and lots of fun!



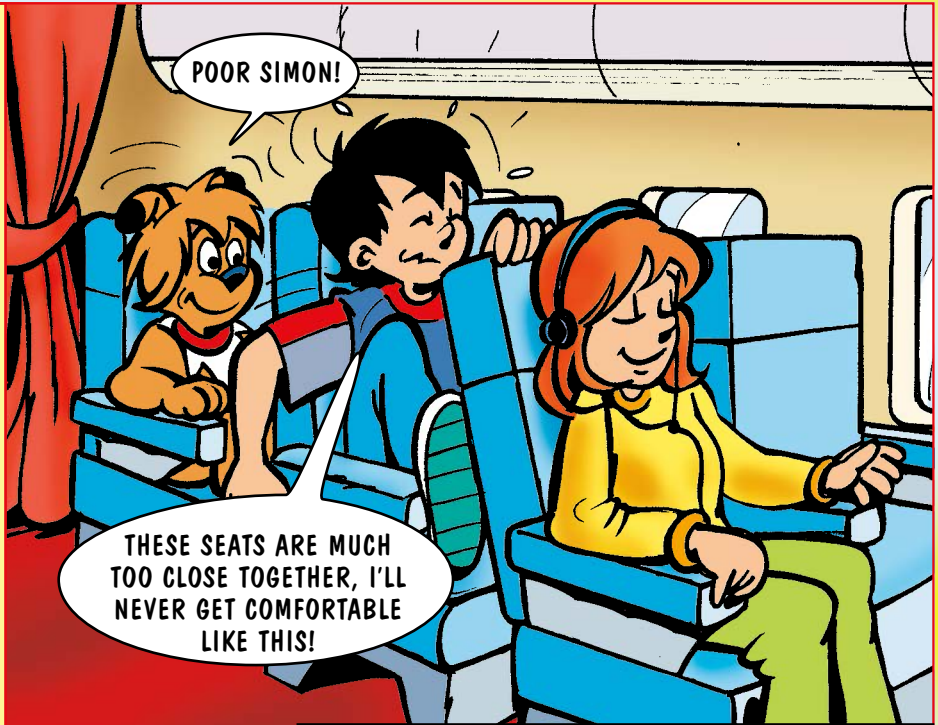
→ **PAWS** is the cute cat who is always ready for some fun and games – except when he needs a nap, of course!

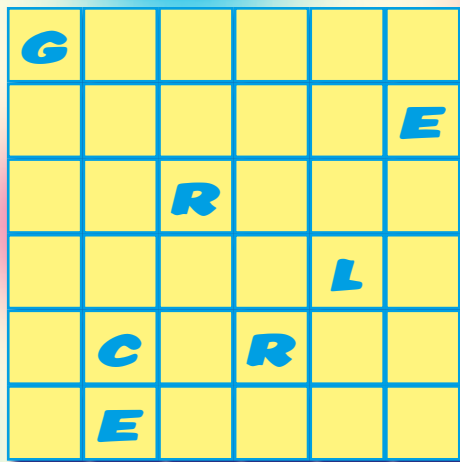

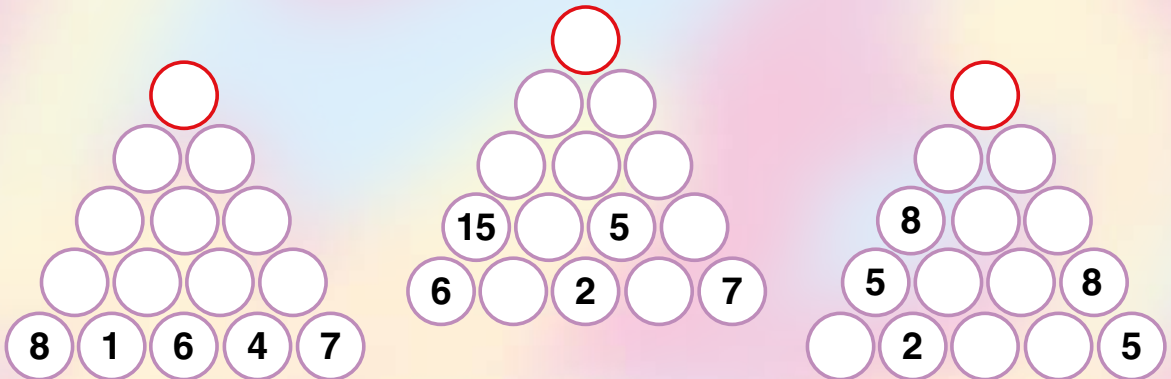

# Pyramids

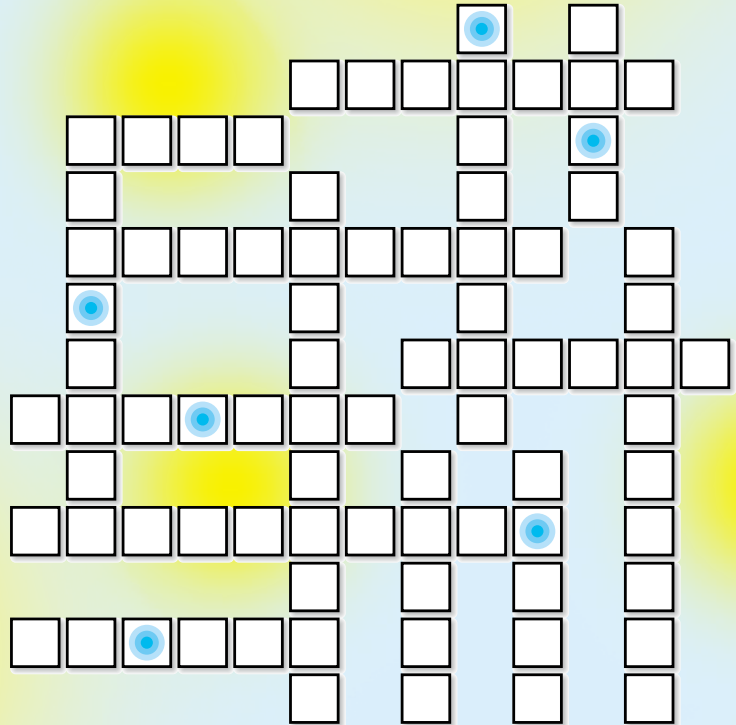
If the number in each circle is the sum of the two below it, how quickly can you figure out the top number? You may have to work up and down the pyramid.
