








How To Solve Word Search

In word search puzzles you are given a list of words which can be found in the diagram. The words read forward, backward, up, down and diagonally. They always read in a straight line and never skip letters. Ring each word you find in the diagram, and then cross through the word in the list so that you know how many more words you have to find. If you see a word or phrase separated by a / it means that the words can be found in two separate places. You might have to use some of the letters in the diagram more than once, as words often overlap, but you won't need to use all the letters.

How To Solve Kriss Kross




