

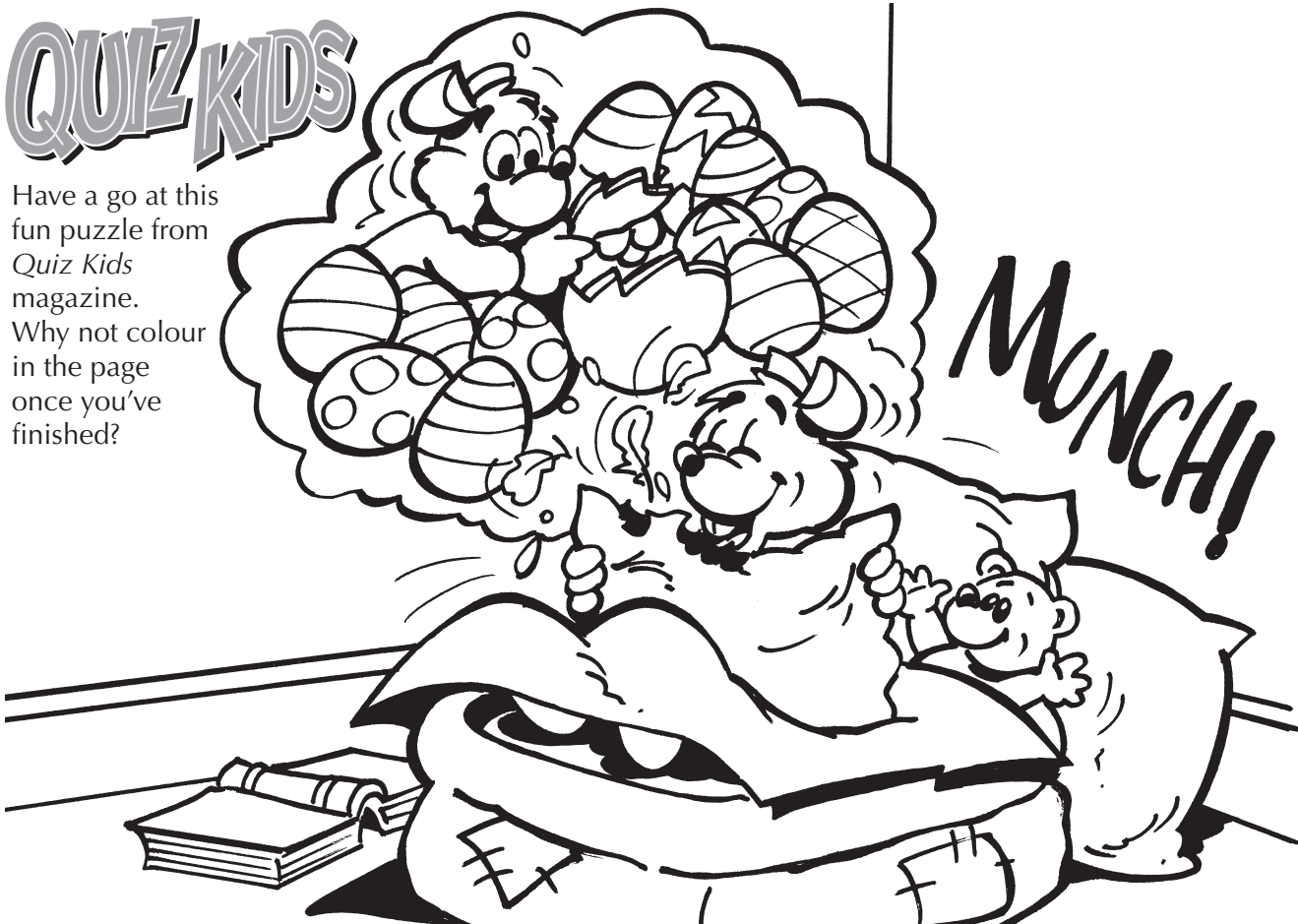

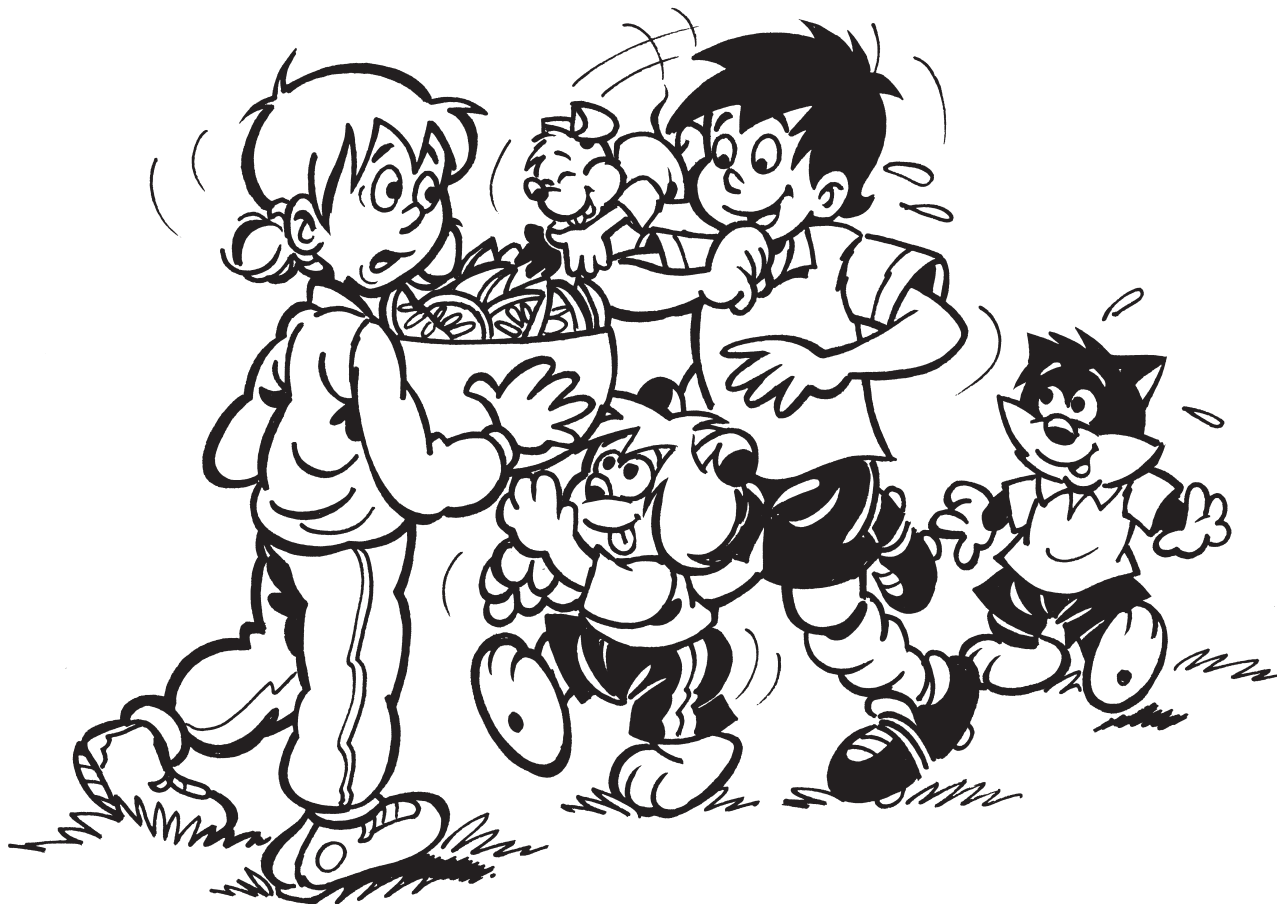

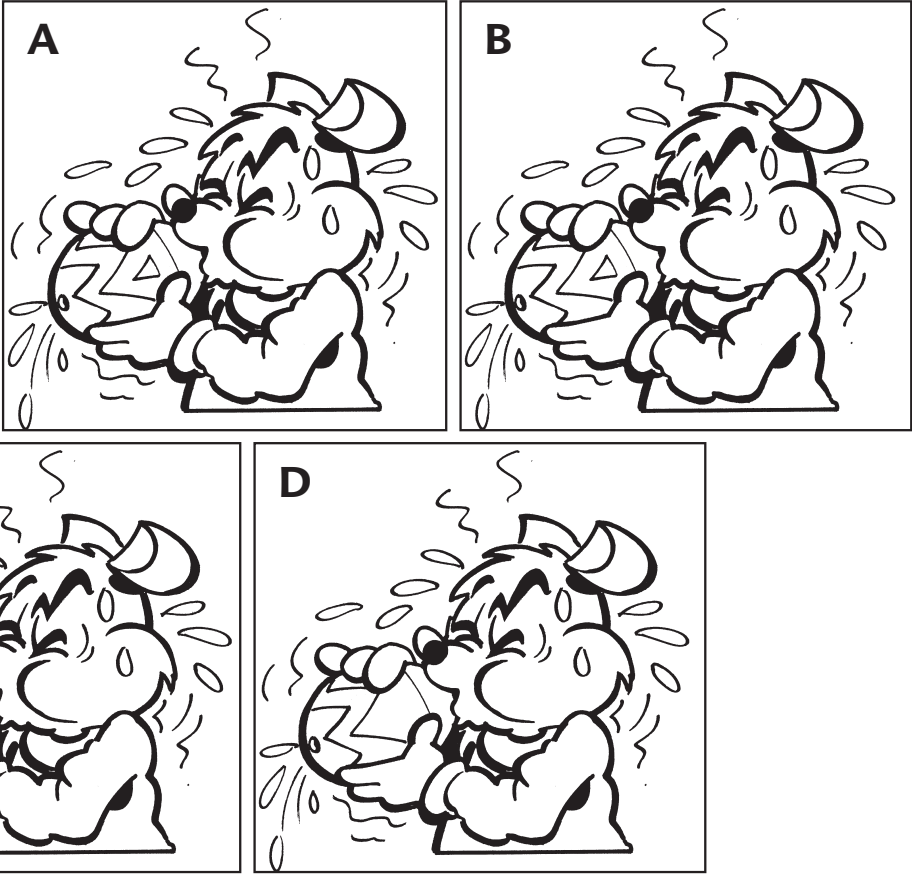

Streetwise is trying to blow the inside out of his egg! One of these pictures is slightly different from the other three. Which one is it?

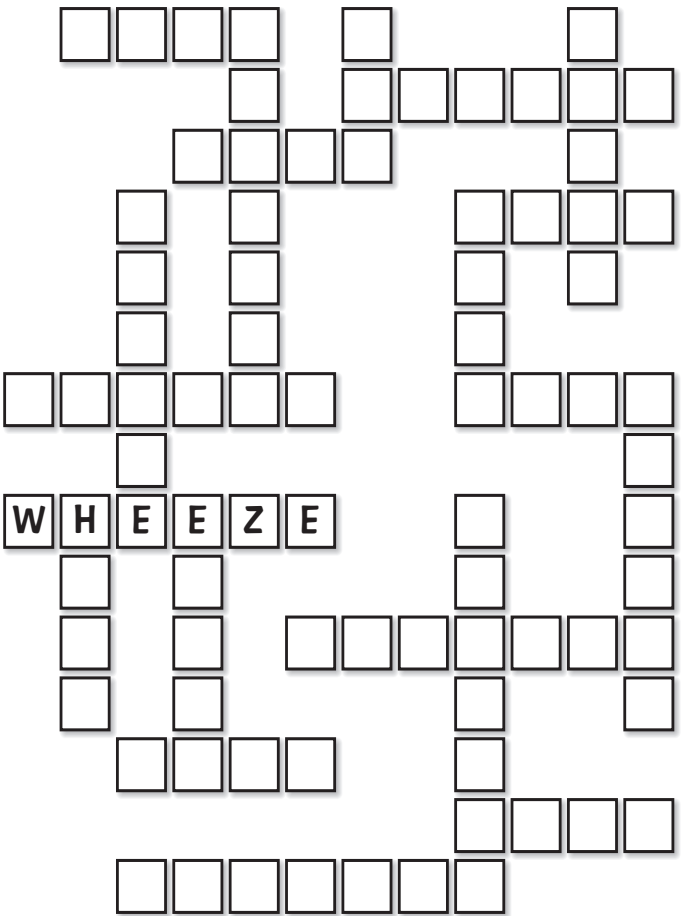
