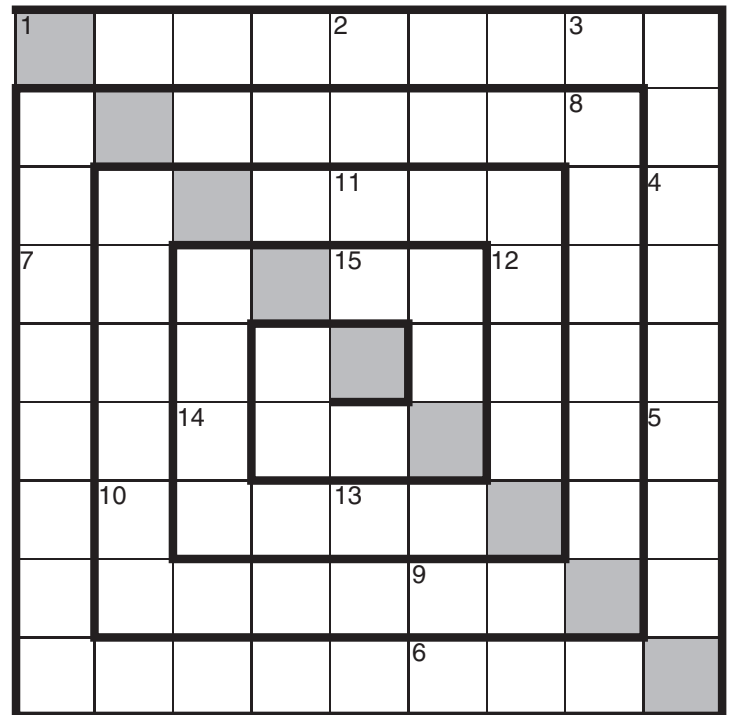

Spiral

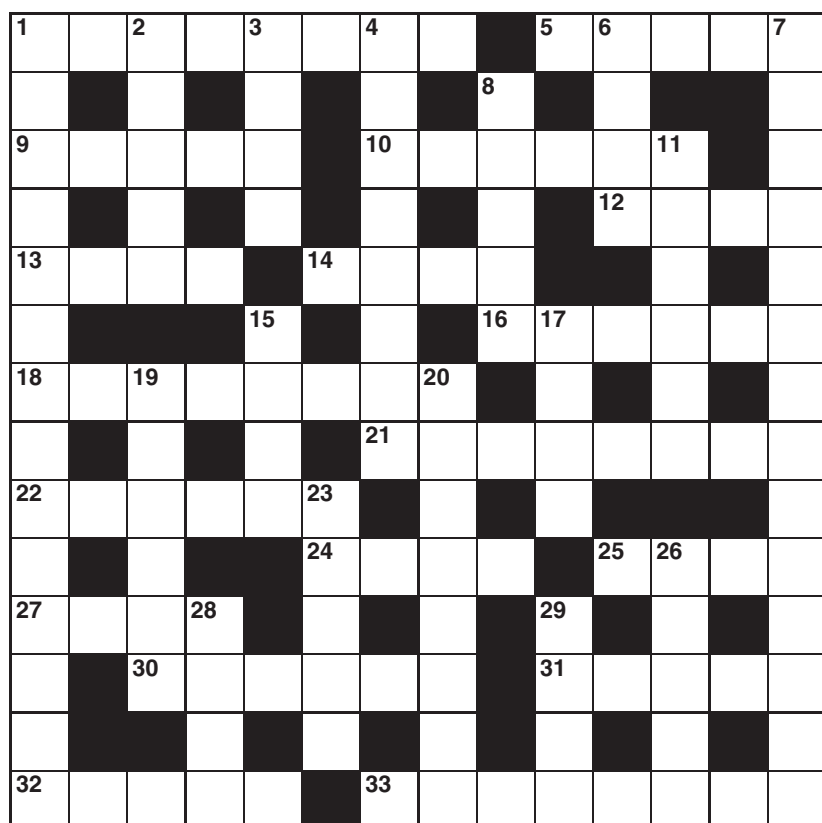

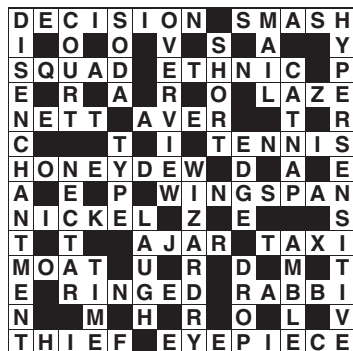
