
Crazy Addition

Fill in the grid so that some of the squares (but not all) contain single-digit numbers. The blue numbers show how many digits are to be positioned in each row and column, whilst the red numbers show the sum total of all the digits. Black cells do not contain digits, and no two digits are in neighbouring squares, not even diagonally. Zero is not used in this puzzle.
