
Round-Tour

A fantastic puzzle in which every square counts at least twice – some count three or four times!

The answer-words form two continuous chains, each of them starting at the top left-hand corner and following the directions of the arrows to and fro along alternate rows, and down and up along alternate columns. Moreover, the last letter of one word is the first letter of the next one. For example, the three consecutive words GINGER, RED and DAVID would appear in the completed puzzle as GINGEREDAVID, so be careful – it's not an easy puzzle!
